Mr. Robert C. Moore, 3rd Degree Black Belt, began his formal training in the school of Ji Do Kwan(Kong Su Do), in Chun Chon, Korea during an overseas assignment with the US Army in March,1962. His teacher was Mr. Nam K. Yun, 3rd Degree Black Belt and his training was directly supervised by Dr. Kwai Byeong Yun, 8th. Degree Black Belt and the Director of the Korean(Kong-Su-Do)Karate Association of Su-Bak(headquarters in Kon-kuk University, Seoul, Korea). Mr. Moore was awarded the rank of 1st. Degree Black belt through the 34th. Regular Examination of Ji-Do-Kwan at Kon-Kuk University on February 12, 1963.

Upon his return to the United States, he was stationed in Fort Riley Kansas, where he organized and directed the Fort Riley Karate Club until his separation from the Army in May 1964.

He then enrolled in Sam Houston State College and in September 1964 where he established the Sam Houston College Karate Team as a college- sanctioned activity, which hosted the 1st. Gulf Coast Invitational Karate Tournament in March 1965, and the 1966 Texas State Karate Championships in April 1966.

On January1, 1966 Mr. Moore was awarded the rank of 3rd. Degree Black Belt by direct appointment of Master Trias.

He has personally helped to establish nine karate clubs within 200 miles of Huntsville, Texas, the U.S.K.A. Texas State Headquarters.

Mr. Moore has fought in many tournaments, and has won several 1st. place and Grand Champion trophies, including his present title of 1966 Texas State Black Belt Champion.

On March 13, 1966, Mr. Moore was appointed to the post of U.S.K.A. National Chairman of the Intercollegiate Karate Division.
